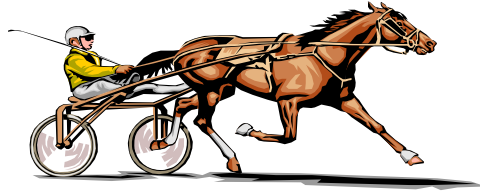


## ANDY ARSENAULT STABLE

We have had our horses drinking water from the Oxygen Diffusion System for two weeks now and I am quite surprised that I am seeing changes in them so quickly. Different changes are happening with each horse and it is amazing.

We have one horse that barely finished drinking a 5 gallon bucket of water in a 12 hour period, ever since he's been on the system he's been drinking up to two buckets a day.

The next horse had quite a stench when he had a bowel movement and before we introduced him to the system we were wondering what he was lacking from, one week after being on the system the stench was gone.

There was a bit of concern three days after they were on the system, nothing to do with the water itself, but we thought a few were getting sick because they started draining clear fluid, (somewhat like a runny nose), it took us a few minutes to realize that they were actually starting to flush out their system. They are all keener in their stalls. It is exciting to actually see this happen right before your eyes. From one day to the next I keep noticing things changing within each one of them. Their coats this week are starting to feel like silk and they are beginning to have a shine to them.

We had a horse last year that had a fungus which was contributed with the limestone on the track, a lot of horses get limestone infection and it goes right into their blood stream. He had patches of hair fall out and he looked horrible, it took three months for him to get rid of it. We have one horse that has a similar reaction to the limestone infection right now, and has lost patches of hair, and she is sore, it started the week before she went on the system, she is actually starting to heal now within the two weeks being on the water and **without having to use drugs**. She gets a corn oil bath and that is it.

We realize this is not going to train our horses for us or make them go out and win, but the few changes health wise that we have witnessed so far is remarkable.
